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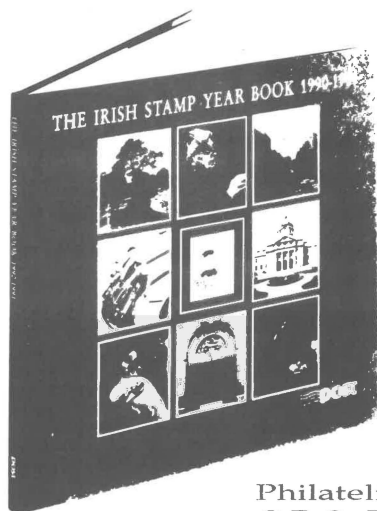

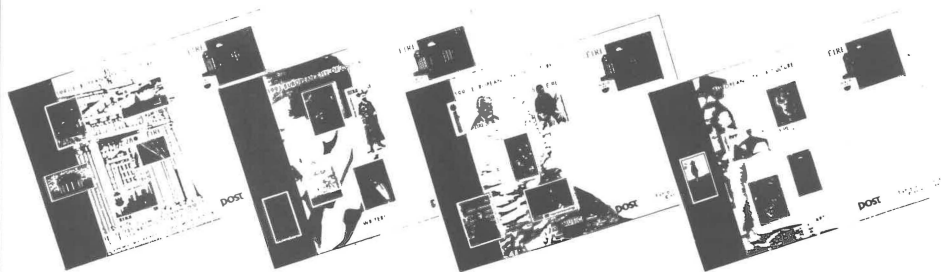

1. *The Grandmother of Europe*

P. Casey, Dublin

A display illustrating the descendants of Queen Victoria down to Elizabeth II who have occupied the Throne of England. The display includes many historical and major events which occurred during the reign of each.

2. *Freemasonry and the Masons*

Introduction showing the appreciation and understanding, early philatelic correspondence (Irish and English), world events and famous Freemasons.

3. *Mozart - His Life and Times*

A bicentennial tribute to the musical genius and the immortal legacy of Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart.

A Historical Perspective of a Country and its Stamps O. MacDonald, Kildare

The stamps and some significant covers of G SWA / SWA / Namibia from the 1890's to 1990.

7. *Revenue Stamps of Great Britain and Ireland*

printed by Perkins Bacon & Co.

The exhibit shows revenue in relation to the Penny Black. GB Life Policy, Playing Card, Ireland Registration of Deeds, GB Customs, Irish Record of Titles, London City Courts (Justice, Mayors and Consultancy).

A. O'Broin, Wexford

An outline of the range of postal stationery.

9. *French Postal History*

W. A. Moore, Dublin

A study of the postmarks and cancellations used in France up to the end of the 19th century. Postal rates have also been examined.

10. *Slogans of Dublin from 1922-1949*

A. O'Broin, Wexford

An outline of the range of slogans used in Dublin City from the establishment of the state to the Declaration of the Republic in 1949.

11. Carlow Postal History

J. Brophy, Carlow

A look at the postal history and markings used on mail of County Carlow.

12. Official Mail Through 100 years 1840-1940

G. E. R. Ithell, England

The concession of Free Franking for individuals was withdrawn when the Penny Post was instituted on May 10th, 1840 and only Government Departments became eligible.
